§2921.05(A)

The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OHIO, do find and present, that the above named Defendant(s), on or about the date of the offense set forth above, in the County of Cuyahoga, unlawfully

did purposely and by force or by unlawful threat of harm to any person or property, retaliate against a public servant, a party official, or an attorney or witness who was involved in a civil or criminal action or proceeding because the public servant, party official, attorney, or witness discharged the duties of the public servant, party official, attorney, or witness.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Two **Disrupting Public Services - F4**
§2909.04(B)

The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find that the Defendant(s) unlawfully

did knowingly use any computer, computer system, computer network, telecommunications device, or other electronic device or system or the internet so as to disrupt, interrupt, or impair the functions of any police, fire, educational, commercial, or governmental operations.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Three **Telecommunications Harassment - M1**
§2917.21(A)(7)
Defendants William Horner
Date of Offense On or about September 1, 2022 to October 17, 2022

The grand jurors, on their oaths, further find that the Defendant(s) unlawfully

did knowingly make or cause to be made a telecommunication, or knowingly permit a telecommunication to be made from a telecommunications device under the person's control, to another, and the caller without a lawful business purpose, knowingly interrupt the telecommunication service of Tonya Jones.
